SUBJECT: Intramural & Interscholastic Sports - 2009-2010

Student athletic participation in the Monroe Middle School **INTRAMURAL** Program is open to all students in all three grade levels. No user fee is required for intramural participation. Sports include flag football, soccer, volleyball, basketball, floor hockey and a games unit. The Intramural Schedule will be included in the August/September Newsletter that will be given to you at Schedule Pick up in August.

Student participation in **INTERSCHOLASTIC** Girls Volleyball, Boys Basketball, Girls Basketball and Track are offered to 7th and 8th graders. A **current sports physical examination** is required on the first day of **tryouts**. If your student is selected for a team, a user fee of \$75 per sport (maximum of 4 user fees per family within District 200 in the current school year) and all school registration fees and outstanding fines must be paid for your student to participate. **There is also an informational parent meeting which must be attended by the player's parent or guardian.**

INTERSCHOLASTIC Cross Country and Wrestling, are open to all students. A user fee of \$75 per sport (maximum of 4 user fees per family within District 200 in the current school year) and a **current sports physical exam** are required prior to the **first day of practice**.

Fall Interscholastic sports are Cross Country and Girls Volleyball. Winter Interscholastic sports are Boys Basketball, Girls Basketball and Wrestling. In the Spring, the Interscholastic sport is Track.

Interscholastic sports compete between District 200 Middle schools and other Middle Schools in other communities. Monroe Intramural sports are for Monroe students only.
